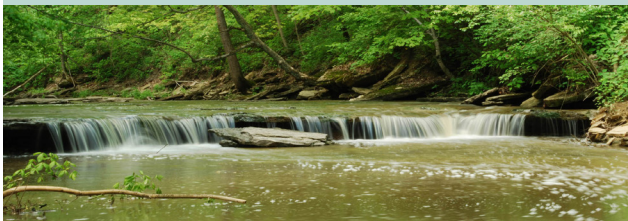


The Williamsburg to Batavia Hike/Bike Trail is a combination of shared roadways and trails. Along some sections of the trail users will be sharing the road with vehicles. Some sections of the trail are old roads that were abandoned during the construction of Harsha Lake. The trail route will take users through a variety of habitats, up and down hills and over creek beds. Take your time on the trail and enjoy this scenic part of Clermont County



The trail begins at the end of Broadway Street in Williamsburg and takes visitors to the campground at East Fork State Park. Currently, the trail is 4.5 miles long. When completed, the length will be 15 miles and will connect to the village of Batavia.
